23rd Masters' International Speed Skating SPRINT CLASSICS 2021 23rd and 24th of January 2021* Max Aicher Arena Inzell / Germany

The competition is to be held in accordance with the following conditions of contest, the Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) at the 400 m covered standard speed skating track of the Max Aicher Arena (MAA) in Inzell on artificial ice. This competition is a regular event on the International Masters' Competition Calendar of the IMSSC.

1. Distances

Ladies and Men 500 m, 1000 m / 500 m, 1000 m (sprint combination).

2. Age Groups

The competitions take place in five year age groups as follows.

3. Participants limitation

The competition is restricted to 120 skaters.

4. Eligibility

To be eligible the skater must be member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU and must have a speed skating license of her/his federation.

5. Drawing, Classification

Drawing will be done in accordance with Rule 3.5 of the IMSSC Constitution and Regulation 2019-2020 v2.

Schutz- und Hygienemaßnahmen

- ✓ **Bei unspezifischen Krankheitssymptomen und Kontakt zu COVID-19-Fällen in den letzten 14 Tagen – kein Sport!**
- ✓ Mindestens 1,5 m Abstand halten
- ✓ Hygieneregeln einhalten
- ✓ Maskenpflicht (Mund- und Nasenschutz) – Buff möglich, Visier nur mit MNS erlaubt!
- ✓ **Die Kontaktflächen der Umkleiden und Toiletten nach Gebrauch reinigen**
- ✓ Leitsystem bei Zutritt und Verlassen der Arena befolgen
- ✓ **Den Anweisungen des Personals ist Folge zu leisten. Bei Zuwiderhandlungen der o.g. Regelungen kann es bis zum Entzug der Eintrittsberechtigung, oder bis zum Stadionverbot der gesamten Gruppe kommen**

Regeln für den Wettkampfbetrieb Eisschnelllauf

- Aufwärmprogramm **nicht** in der Arena, ausgenommen im persönlichen Aufwämbereich
- Teilnehmer sind für ihre **Armschleifen selbst verantwortlich** – Kauf bei der Kasse möglich!
- max. 50 Teilnehmer auf dem Eis – **kein Ausfahren auf dem Eis!**
- die Beschränkung der aktuellen Teilnehmer zur Erwärmung auf dem Eis, wird durch die Transponderausgabe geregelt. Faustregel: 20 min. vor dem Start wird dem Teilnehmer der Transponder ausgehändigt!
- nach Beendigung des Wettkampfes ist die Arena so rasch als möglich zu verlassen
- Der öffentliche Bereich ist die Zuschauertribüne für den Eisschnelllauf (Sektor A3 bis A5). Die Gesamtzahl von 200 Zuschauern darf nicht überschritten werden und diese müssen an den gekennzeichneten und zugewiesenen Bereichen Platz nehmen
- Raucherbereich und Kiosk ist außerhalb der Arena und kann über den Ausgang in Sektor A1 erreicht werden
- Unter Vorbehalt ist für auswärtige Athleten das Duschen nicht erlaubt!

Most important measures for competition operations (speed skating)

Registration in the foyer at the main entrance (online or paper form) or documents are provided on our website.

Protective and hygiene measures

- ✓ In the event of unspecific symptoms of illness and contact with COVID-19 cases in the last 14 days - no sport!
- ✓ Keep a distance of at least 1.5 m
- ✓ Comply with hygiene rules
- ✓ Mask compulsory (mouth and nose protection) - Buff possible, visor only allowed with MNS!
- ✓ Clean the contact surfaces of the changing rooms and toilets after use
- ✓ Follow the guidance system when entering and leaving the arena
- ✓ The instructions of the staff must be followed. In the event of violations of the above Regulations can result in the withdrawal of entry authorization or the stadium ban for the entire group

Rules for speed skating competitions

- Warm-up program **not** in the arena, except in the personal warm-up area
- **Participants are responsible for their arm bows** - they can be bought at the cash register!
- Max. 50 participants on the ice - **no cool down** on the ice!
- The restriction of the current participants to warm up on the ice is regulated by the transponder issue. Rule of thumb: 20 min. The transponder will be given to the participant before the start!
- Leave the arena as soon as possible after the end of the competition
- The public area is the spectator stand for speed skating (sector A3 to A5). The total number of 200 spectators must not be exceeded and they must take their places in the marked and assigned areas
- The smoking area and kiosk is outside the arena and can be reached via the exit in sector A1
- With reservations, showering is not allowed for athletes from other countries!
