# 21<sup>st</sup> Masters' International Speed Skating SPRINT CLASSICS 2019 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> of January 2019 Max Aicher Arena Inzell / Germany

The competition is to be held in accordance with the following conditions of contest, the Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Regulations of the International Masters' Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) at the 400 m covered standard speed skating track of the Max Aicher Arena (MAA) in Inzell on artificial ice. This competition is a regular event on the International Masters' Competition Calendar of the IMSSC.

## 1. Distances

Ladies and Men 500 m, 1000 m / 500 m, 1000 m (sprint combination).

## 2. Age Groups

The competitions take place in five year age groups as follows. AG = five year age groups Ladies and Men Masters (from 30) as high as necessary

## 3. Participants limitation

The competition is restricted to 120 skaters.

## 4. Eligibility

To be eligible the skater must be member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU and must have a license of his federation.

## 5. Drawing, Classification

Generally, the age groups are drawn separately. If the number of competitors is very small in one or several of the five years age groups, neighbored 5 years age groups may be joined for drawing and speedskating. But the allotting of track on the third distance is decided by the ranking after two distances for each 5 years age group, and not by the ranking in the joined, neighbored groups. The final distance drawing and classification must be done in her/his own age group independent of the number of participants in that age group.

The winner of the sprint combination in a five years age group is the skater who has completed successfully all distances and has obtained the lowest total of points.

## 6. Prices and Minutes

All participants, who skate successfully the four distances contest, obtain a certificate and minutes including end times. The Places 1, 2 and 3 of each 5 years group obtain a medal.
