Procedure for seniors mass start: If more than 28 participants register, 2 runs will take place based on the 1500m sb (pb). A separate junior run will only take place after registration of at least 12 juniors.

Bestimmungen / Regulations

The competition will be held in accordance with the German competition regulations (DWO).

Citizenship / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2030, any skater who is not a citizen of the ISU Member's country, whom the ISU Member intends to enter, or who is a citizen of the ISU Member's country and who has in the past represented another Member in Intern. Competition in the coming season, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Anti-Doping

The Anti-Doping testing conducted In-Competition under the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures (ISU Communications 2344 and 2366 or any updated versions) are in full compliance with the World Anti-Doping Code.
