## TRACK

A Standard speeds skating track of 400meters to the lap laid out at the Max Alcher Arena, an artificially frozen indoor skating rink in Inzell, Germany. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 25 and 29 meters respectively. The width of the inside warm-up lane is 5 metres.

## ENTRIES

Entries for this competition will be restricted in accordance with the participating countries Finland (8 quota places), SUI (15 quota places), Great Britain (6 quota places), Danmark (4 quota places), France (6 quota places) and Belgium (15 quota places). #### **PRELIMINARY MEASURES FOR HOLDING THE COMPETITION**

- ✓ Warming up is not permitted in the arena, except in the personal warm up area
- ✓ Participants are responsible for their arm bows – they can be bought at the cash register!
- ✓ Max. 50 participants on the ice
- ✓ The restriction of the current participants to warm up on the ice is regulated by the transponder issue. Rule: 20min. the transponder will be given to the participant.
- ✓ No cool down on the ice
- ✓ Leave the Arena as soon as possible after the competition.
